Committee Reports

Worship: The lack of fill-in pastors was discussed. Lori Callahan has offered to lead services so finding someone to lead is no longer an issue. Beth brought up the possibility of Pastor Jordan finding his own replacements when he needs days off since he might have more connections to clergy members than Heidi. With Pastor Jordan's approval, we decided to cancel the 4th of July service & hold an outdoor service in its place on 7/21 to celebrate the formal organization of the church 65 years ago. We will recognize some of the original members/ministers, have the children sing songs they learned at VBS & serve root beer floats afterwards. Beth will ask Sarah if she's willing to lead the kids & Jamie/Heidi will be in charge of the floats. Beth will talk to Cheryl Ness & Lori Callahan about the original members & former ministers. Christine & Heidi will look for an outdoor audio system. Beth will call the Hutterites to do a thorough cleaning in the basement & inquire about reupholstering the pew cushions as the cost to replace them was quite high. A rep from Waggoner's will be stopping through & give us a quote this month. The Sunday school materials need to be organized & stored and the mop boards need to be put back on after the basement is cleaned. Beth will ask Larry Coon to spray the church yard for weeds. **Youth:** Beth lined up counselors from Red Willow Bible Camp to lead VBS hosted by ORLC. The cost is \$40

per child. The Andrys will provide room & board and snacks & drinks during VBS. VBS dates are Sun. 7/18 from 3-6 pm, Mon. 7/19 & Tues. 7/20 from 9 am – 3 pm. Allie Lagodinski & Addi Goebel will hang up posters throughout town to invite other children in the community. Pastor Jordan would like to hold one more live confirmation class before breaking for the summer. He plans to resume in the fall & have the class finish by Jan. 2022.
