Property: Gary fixed the ballast in the council room & got the LL kids to move the pew with the memorial plaque back into the entry way.

Fellowship: Beth & Heidi Kaatz will arrange for cupcakes, juice & coffee to be served after the ceremonies on May 15th. Kathy DeBolt will decorate & put together gift baskets/bags.

Unfinished Old Business: Jamie offered to call Direct Electric & get photos of the different sanctuary lights. Pastor Jordan discussed going back to traditional communion with some of the servers. They like using the disposable cups. He thought Delores Lux might be willing to help out if we wanted to do traditional communion once a month. Jamie suggested a compromise by bringing the disposable cups up to the altar for a blessing. The Ellingson vow renewal will take place on May 14th. After some discussion, all agreed that once a month would be a good start. Pastor Jordan will put it on the schedule.
