

ORLC 3Q23 MEETING 06/28/2023

Old business:

Roof, Window Tints: Received two bids for the labor for the roof. Lucas Madcke's is \$9,000 and Tyler Lagodinski's is \$7,800. Unanimous vote (minus Jamie) for Tyler to fix the roof.

Jamie called on the window tinting and hasn't heard back. She will continue to try.

Church calendar/schedule - Pastor said that Lori mentioned things like baptism supplies and things need to be checked out and ordered. Sandy said she will meet with Lori to go over everything and also do a master calendar for the church.

CD/Savings Accounts - there are local banks that currently have 4% or more to invest our CD and any money that does not need to be fluid for at least 6 months. Jamie suggested taking \$25,000 and putting it into a 4% or higher CD. We will find one locally and send out to council for agreement.

VBS - We will skip VBS this year. Our goal is to get Sunday School back up and going, whatever that may look like.

Lawncare - Cooks have been mowing the lawn and will be sending out bills to those who volunteered to cover that week.

New business:

Outdoor Sunday School Rally - Jamie will send out an email and ask opinions on a date. Jamie will check on new second graders so they can get their bible at Rally Sunday.

Compensation- Amanda had previously brought up paying Pastor and Sarah for their extra time in confirmation. Jordan said they both looked at it as volunteerism and payment was not expected. Council will have a side discussion on where to go from here.

Sandy asked if Lori and Kathy were compensated for all of the extra things they did for the church. They are not. Council voted and agreed on gift basket worth appx. \$75 for each of them. Jayette or Jamie will get them ordered through Country Gardens/Backroads Coffee

Pastor Jordan's Report/Comments:

Missionary - Jessica Kusler will be in church to speak 7/9/23 and update the congregation on what she is doing.

No service - There is no service July 2nd. Jim posted a reminder on FB.

Pastor time off - Pastor wanted to know what dates he has had off this year. Jamie gave him that information.
